

Eligibility

The tuition waiver program is designed to enable retired full time employees, their spouses, and/or their dependent children to enroll in for credit courses at the University of Denver with reduced or no tuition charges.

Activation of the Tuition Waiver

The tuition waiver must be requested/applied to each course every academic period via PioneerWeb .

The tuition waiver must be **re-requested** to any course that has been changed.

- o Changes include add/drop of course, section, etc.
- o The waiver must be re-requested by the deadline.

Application deadline: All tuition waiver users must request by the, "100% Drop" deadline.
