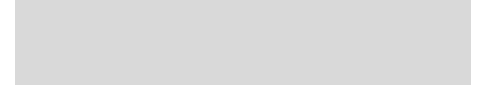
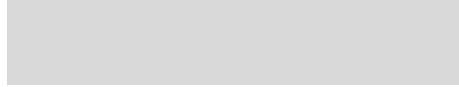

## Details about Incidents of Sexual Assault

Students who were sexually assaulted were asked a series of questions about details of the assault. These questions appear on the "Details about Incidents of Sexual Assault" tab. Students who were sexually assaulted multiple times were asked to focus on only one incident of sexual assault when answering these questions. The majority of victims of sexual assault experienced more than one assault, and information on this tab reflects the one assault they chose to describe, not all the incidents they experienced.

Students who answered "One person" in Q17—"How many people sexually assaulted you?"—saw Branch A. Students who answered "More than one person" or "I am not sure" in Q17, or who saw Q17 but did not respond, saw Branch B. Questions in Branch A and B are identical, but sometimes Branch B employs the plural form. We have combined questions from Branches A and B into the frequencies we show for Q18–Q34.
